Task 4 – Assessment of Base Case

Questionnaire No.2 – seeking detailed product data

Components and process for each phase:

- production, especially Bill of Materials (BOM)
- distribution
- use (product and system)
- end-of-life

Based on average current product

Provides average environmental impacts over all phases

- Criterion 2: significant environmental impact within EU

Provides Life Cycle Costs (LCC) and total EU consumer spend/year

EuP EcoReport (spreadsheet-based)

Task 5 - Technical Analysis of BAT & BNAT

Builds on the information from Tasks 1 to 4

Identification and analysis of Best Available Technology (BAT) and Best Next Available Technology (BNAT)

EU and global

Feed into design options

2nd Stakeholder Workshop

To put forward findings to date

To gather information to fill gaps identified

To inform Tasks 4 & 5
